To elect a sitting Member of the States as a member of the Commerce and Employment Department to complete the unexpired portion of the term of office of Deputy R.W Sillars, who has resigned as a member of that Department, namely to serve until May 2012 in accordance with Rule 7 of the Constitution and Operation of States Departments and Committees.

(N.B. Paragraph 7(7) of the Rules relating to the Constitution and Operation of States Departments and Committees states:

“If a member elected by the States to a Department ... tenders his resignation from that office in a letter to the Minister of the Department ..., and does not include in that letter a request that the matter be debated by the States, his resignation shall automatically take effect on the election by the States of a new member of that Department ... in his place.”

In this case Deputy Sillars has not asked that the matter be debated.)
