ELECTION OF JURAT

In accordance with the provisions of section 5(2) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, an election was held, by secret ballot, for the office of Jurat of the Royal Court to replace Derek Martin Le Page who, under the operation of section 5(1) of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950, ceased to hold office by reason of age on the 13th December, 2009.

One hundred members were present at the meeting. Two ballots were necessary, and the Deputy President declared Niall David McCathie duly elected and requested Her Majesty's Sheriff to invite Mr McCathie to attend the sitting of the Royal Court at 9.30 am on Monday 1 March 2010, to take the Oath attaching to the office of Jurat of the Royal Court.
