dated 8th October 2010**

ELECTION OF JURAT

In accordance with the provisions of section 5(2) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, an election was held, by secret ballot, for the office of Jurat of the Royal Court to replace Jurat Michael John Tanguy who, under the operation of section 5(1) of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950, ceased to hold office by reason of age on the 14th July, 2010.

The following candidates were duly proposed and seconded, namely: -

The following were appointed Scrutineers: -

Two ballots were necessary.

The result of the first ballot was as follows: -

There were 4 blank papers and 1 spoiled paper.

The result of the second ballot was as follows: -
