## **Environment Department**

The Environment Department is responsible for: -

- 1. The protection of the physical environment from activities that might otherwise compromise the well being of the community;
- 2. The conservation and enhancement of the natural and semi-natural environment;
- 3. Spatial/land use policy to enable the sustainable management of transport, energy resources, waste disposal and natural resources in accordance with the strategic policies of the States;
- 4. Transport policy to enable the safe and efficient movement of people and goods around the Island including traffic management, road safety and the regulation of public transport;
- 5. The management of the natural and semi-natural environment of States owned land including sites of nature conservation importance, cliff paths, beaches, headlands, Herm and Lihou islands and other public areas and parks, gardens and plantations;
- 6. The promotion and coordination of environmental issues and initiatives;
- 7. The provision of an integrated land use planning system including the processing of all development applications of all kinds (planning, building control, protected buildings and scheduled sites);
- 8. Vehicle registration and vehicle and driver licensing
