**ELECTION OF JURAT**

In accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, an election was held, by secret ballot, for the office of Jurat of the Royal Court to replace Mr Michael John Wilson who died on 2<sup>nd</sup> May, 2005.
