TO THE MEMBERS OF THE STATES OF ELECTION OF THE ISLAND OF GUERNSEY

I have the honour to inform you that a Meeting of the States of Election will be held at **THE ROYAL COURT HOUSE**, on **WEDNESDAY**, the **29th JUNE 2005**, at 9.30 a.m., for the purpose of electing a Jurat in the place of Michael John Wilson, who died on the 2nd May, 2005.

Nominations must be in writing (suitable forms are available at my office on request) and must be made and seconded by a Member of the States of Election or by a Douzenier and must reach me by 4pm on the 13th June, 2005. A nomination must be accompanied by a certificate in writing, signed by the candidate, stating his or her willingness to serve in the office of Jurat if elected.

I remind you that, for the purpose of the election of a Jurat, the States of Election is composed of the following:-

The Rectors or Priests-in-Charge (subject to the provisions of the Reform (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1984

H.M. Procureur

H.M. Comptroller

The People's Deputies

Thirty-four Douzaine Representatives elected for a particular meeting of the States of Election by their respective Douzaines as follows:-

Will the Constables of the above-mentioned Parishes kindly convene their respective Douzaines for the purpose of electing for the Meeting of the 29th June, the appropriate number of Douzaine Representatives and deliver to Her Majesty's Greffier not later than 3pm on the 28th June, 2005, a certificate, signed by the Constables as to the Douzaine Representatives so elected.

Notice of nominations, as they are received, will be posted in the lobby of the Royal Court and, when the period for receiving nominations has expired, a further notice concerning all those received will be published in "La Gazette Officielle".
