TO THE MEMBERS OF THE STATES OF
ELECTION OF THE ISLAND OF GUERNSEY

I have the honour to inform you that a Meeting of the States of Election will be held at **THE ROYAL COURT HOUSE**, on **WEDNESDAY**, the **27th JULY 2005**, at 9.30 a.m., for the purpose of electing a Jurat in the place of Laurence Lenfestey Guille, who, under the operation of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950, will ceased to hold office by reason of age on the 6th July, 2005.

Nominations must be in writing (suitable forms are available at my office on request) and must be made and seconded by a Member of the States of Election or by a Douzenier and must reach me by 4 p.m. on the 11th July, 2005. A nomination must be accompanied by a certificate in writing, signed by the candidate, stating his or her willingness to serve in the office of Jurat if elected.

I remind you that, for the purpose of the election of a Jurat, the States of Election is composed of the following:—

The Bailiff

The Jurats

The Rectors or Priests-in-Charge (subject to the provisions of the Reform (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1984)

H.M. Procureur

H.M. Comptroller

The People's Deputies

Thirty-four Douzaine Representatives elected for a particular meeting of the States of Election by their respective Douzaines, as follows:—

Will the Constables of the above-mentioned Parishes kindly convene their respective Douzaines for the purpose of electing for the Meeting of the 27th July, the appropriate number of Douzaine Representatives and deliver to Her Majesty's Greffier not later than 3 p.m. on the 26th July, 2005, a certificate, signed by the Constables as to the Douzaine Representatives so elected.

Notice of nominations, as they are received, will be posted in the lobby of the Royal Court and, when the period for receiving nominations has expired, a further notice concerning all those received will be published in "La Gazette Officielle".

The result of the ballot was as follows: -

The Bailiff declared Mr David Osmond Le Conte duly elected and requested Her Majesty's Sheriff to invite Mr Le Conte to attend the sitting of the Royal Court at 9.30am on Monday, 1st August, 2005, to take the Oath attaching to the office of Jurat of the Royal Court.
