CONTINUITY OF ESSENTIAL TRANSPORT LINKS

After consideration of the attached report dated the 1st day of October, 2001 of the Advisory and Finance Committee, THE STATES RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. To authorise the States Advisory and Finance Committee to give and honour undertakings on behalf of the States of Guernsey to indemnify or otherwise underwrite the liabilities of any organisation providing commercial services in the Bailiwick of Guernsey relating to air transport, in respect of third party war, terrorism and related risks, on such terms and conditions as that Committee may determine.
- 2. To authorise the States Advisory and Finance Committee to take such other measures as may be considered necessary to ensure the continuity of essential transport services whilst minimising the risk to public funds and to report back to the States with details of any such action taken.
- 3. To annul the State of Emergency (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Order, 2001 and the State of Emergency (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2001.
