ELECTION OF NON-VOTING MEMBERS

The States are asked:-

- I.- To elect as a non-voting member of the Health and Social Services Department, Dr Roger Henry Allsopp OBE, who has been nominated in that behalf by that Department, to serve until May 2016 in accordance with Rule 4 (2) of the Constitution and Operation of States Departments and Committees.

- II.- To elect as a non-voting member of the Health and Social Services Department, Dr Alex Christou, who has been nominated in that behalf by that Department, to serve until May 2016 in accordance with Rule 4 (2) of the Constitution and Operation of States Departments and Committees.

N.B. Rule 4 (2) of the Constitution and Operation of States Departments and Committees states:

Any Department may nominate up to two non-voting members, who shall not be sitting Members of the States, and whose appointments shall expire at the same time as the terms of office of the four sitting Members of the States. No other nomination may be made. Such Members shall have the same rights and duties as ordinary Members (other than the right to vote).

Pursuant to Rule 12 of the Constitution and Operation of States Departments and Committees:

The proposer shall provide to Members of the States, no later than the start of the meeting at which the election is to be held, a full report in writing containing background information about the candidate, the candidate's willingness to seek election and the reasons for his name having been put forward.
