

**REPLY BY THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CIVIL CONTINGENCIES AUTHORITY TO
QUESTIONS ASKED PURSUANT TO RULE 6 OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURE
BY DEPUTY LOWE**

Question 1

In respect of each month during the periods May 2012 - December 2012 and January 2013 - December 2013 & January 2014 - December 2014:

- a) How many flights paid for by the States did the political members of Civil Contingencies Authority take?*
- b) To which destinations did the political members of Civil Contingencies Authority travel on those flights?*
- c) What were the departure and return dates in respect of each trip from Guernsey?*
