### Note 1.

- First Provisional licence and renewal of Provisional licence in categories P, A1, A, B1, F, G, or L will be issued for 2 years only. Applicants must wait 12 months between renewals except in motorcycle categories P, A1 & A which can be renewed **prior** to expiry provided that the applicant holds a valid CBT. The applicant will then have to take a 'Direct Access' training course within one month of licence renewal.
- Full licences are normally issued for a maximum of 10 years to expire the month prior to a decade birthday.
- If a medical report is required with your application, the duration would be a maximum of 5 years, but may be less based on your medical condition and age.

## Appendix 1 – First Registration Duty

### Calculating the cost of the Duty

The established carbon dioxide emissions figure for the motor vehicle is used to calculate the Duty applied and will only be accepted from an official document (principally a 'motor vehicle registration certificate', 'V55 Registration form', 'Certificate of Conformity' or 'Type Approval Certificate'). If the motor vehicle does not have an established carbon dioxide emissions figure, then the motor vehicle's established engine size figure will be used instead.

Unless exempt, the Duty shall be levied as per the following tables.
