Policy Council Access to Neighbouring Land

To add a further proposition as follows:

“3. To direct the Commerce and Employment Department, after consultation with the Treasury and Resources, Public Services and Environment Departments and any other States Departments or other parties interested in this matter, to submit a report to the States regarding improved statutory rights for the Island’s utility companies for the laying and maintenance of services in private land, not later than May 2015.”

Explanatory Note

Paragraph 44 (page 1021, Billet d'État No. X) of the Policy Council’s States report entitled “Access to Neighbouring Land” highlights the intention for “*relevant States’ Departments*” to report further to the States “*regarding improved statutory rights for the Island’s utility companies for laying and maintenance of services in private land*”. The purpose of this Amendment is to direct the Department taking a lead in this matter to consult with the other States Departments with relevant mandated responsibilities, and with other stakeholders, and to report to the States of Deliberation in a timely manner, using existing resources.
