Explanatory note

Charging for dry recycling bags could have a negative impact on kerbside recycling given that the bring banks are free for the public to use for dry recycling.

The possible income shortfall could be made up with adjustment to the black bag charge (which could still be within £1.50 to £2.00 charge per bag)
