In the Schedule to the Ordinance entitled "The Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2013", in the substituted Table 1, printed at page 38 of the brochure, for "£500", substitute "£515".

Explanatory note

The above amendment to the Supplementary Benefit (Implementation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2013 (as printed in the brochure to Billet d'État XXII of 2013) implements the proposal approved by the States of Deliberation on the 14th November, 2013 to increase the weekly supplementary benefit limitation for a person living in the community to £515.00.

Increasing the benefit limitation for a person living in the community to £515 per week will increase supplementary benefit expenditure by an estimated £20,000 per year. In accordance with the requirements of Rule 15(2) of the Rules of Procedure (which relates to a proposition which may have the effect of increasing revenue expenditure), the Department indicates that the estimated £20,000 of additional revenue expenditure will be funded from the budget reserve and is not anticipated to have any effect upon the States Fiscal and Economic Policy Plan.
