<u>Public Services Department</u> Waste Strategy – Household Waste Charging Mechanisms

To insert in Proposition 2 a), immediately after "in section 3 of that report", ", but that there should be no charge for dry re-cycling bags".

Explanatory note

Charging for dry recycling bags could have a negative impact on kerbside recycling given that the bring banks are free for the public to use for dry recycling.

The possible income shortfall could be made up with adjustment to the black bag charge (which could still be within £1.50 to £2.00 charge per bag)
