Requete

Island Wide Voting

To delete Proposition 1 and to substitute the following:

“1. To approve that a referendum on Island Wide Voting shall be held, such referendum to be held on the date of the next General Election in 2016.”

Explanatory Note

If the amendment is carried Proposition 2 will remain in place thus requiring the States Assembly and Constitution Committee to report on the changes, including legislative changes, which are required to give effect to the decision to hold the referendum
